

Information on H1n1 Flu

Dear Parents and Guardians,

In preparation of the 2009-2010 school year we have been working with our local health department on procedures to keep our students and staff safe during the influenza period. These are the steps that will be taken to prevent the spread of the flu virus.

- Frequent hand washing.
- Hand sanitizer in all classrooms, offices and lunchroom.
- Washing of water fountains, handrails, doorknobs and desks with a bleach mixture daily.
- If your child is sick **do not** send your child to school.
- Students that show sign of illness will be given a face mask to wear, will be isolated from students and parents will be asked to pick up their child.
- Parents will fill out permission forms to have their child vaccinated.
- Nurses from the health department will come to the school and vaccinate the students and staff.
- School hours may be revised.
- If 30% of students are absent or there are not enough teachers to cover the classrooms, the school may be closed.

We are working closely with the health department and will inform parents on any changes that there might be.
