St. Xavier School has a no-cut policy so all students interested in participating will be on the team as long as they meet the eligibility requirements regarding academics. In addition, St. Xavier has cooperative agreements with Junction City High School that allow our students to participate in activities not available on our campus to include cross country, soccer, baseball and softball.

# ACADEMIC INFORMATION

## PRESCHOOL

Half-day classes are available in the morning or afternoon. Religion, self-esteem, social skills, language, science, math & computers are included in the curriculum.

## KINDERGARTEN

Full day classes are available. Curriculum includes religion, language arts, science, math, social studies, computers, physical education, music and library.

## GRADES 1-4 (ELEMENTARY)

Religion, math, language arts, science, social studies, physical education, music, computers and library are included in the curriculum.

## GRADES 5-8 (INTERMEDIATE)

Religion, math, English, science, social studies, physical education, computers, music and band are included in the curriculum.

## GRADES 9-12 (HIGH SCHOOL)

**Fine Arts:** Speech, Choir, Band

**Science:** Physical Science, Earth Science, Chemistry, Physics, Biology I

**Religious Education:** Catholic Doctrine & Tradition, Bible Study, Sacrament Preparation for Reconciliation, Eucharist & Confirmation

**Physical Education:** Health, Physical Education, Body Fitness, Weight Lifting

**Mathematics:** Pre-Algebra, Algebra I & II, Geometry, Advanced Math

**Social Science:** World History, U.S. History, Government, Current Affairs

**Foreign Language:** Spanish (online)

**Language Arts:** Publications, English, Forensics

**Computer Technology:** Intro to Business, Computer Applications I & II

**Virtual Education:** Virtual Education is offered as an alternative instructional delivery system. Classes may be offered to select students. More detailed information may be found in the “Course Handbook.”



## MASS & THEOLOGY

Students in grades K-12 attend Mass every Wednesday and Friday as well as Holy Days of Obligation. Students attend daily theology classes.

## PARKER UNIFORMS

Students in grades K-12 are required to wear approved school uniforms. Uniforms may be purchased from Parker Uniforms online ([www.parkersu.com](http://www.parkersu.com)) —”enter store” and then use school id W1104163 — or you may order via telephone (800-500-4634). The school also maintains a “clothes closet” of used school uniforms.

## REGISTRATION, FEES AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Preschool and kindergarten roundups are held annually in April. An enrollment fee is required. Preschool tuition is paid according to sessions attended from September – May.

While new students are accepted at any time of the year, registration is held in July of each year. Announcements are made in local media, the church bulletin and on the school marquee regarding dates and times. Parents/guardians are responsible for curriculum and registration fees during registration. The tuition is paid in 10 monthly increments beginning in September with completion of payments at the end of June.

St. Xavier parishioners who tithe throughout the year must pay registration and curriculum fees in addition to their regular tithe. They are not required to pay tuition.

St. Xavier tuition fees are negotiable and are based upon the size of the family and need of non-parishioners.
